MONTHLY REPORTS

Reports shall be filed on the 10th day following the end of a calendar month from the time the campaign treasurer is appointed, except that if the 10th day following the end of a calendar month occurs on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the report shall be filed on the following day that is not a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday [F.S. 106.07(1)]. Additionally, reports must be filed on the 25th, 11th, and 4th days preceding the Election [Division of Elections Formal Opinion 98-03].

Additional Information

Campaign Treasurer's Reports must be filed with the Village Clerk/Supervisor of Elections. Reports must be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on the day designated and are subject to a fine if designated late, in accordance with Florida Statute 106.07. Failure to file a report on the designated due date shall subject the candidate to a fine of \$50 per day for the first 3 days late and, thereafter, \$500 per day for each late day; not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report. However, for the reports immediately preceding each primary and general election, the fine shall be \$500 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25% of the total receipts or expenditures whichever is greater, for the period covered by the late report, as provided in F.S. Section 106.07(8). For a candidate's termination report, the fine shall be \$50 per day for each late day, not to exceed 25 percent of the total receipts or expenditures, whichever is greater for the period covered by the late report. **All fines must be paid from the candidate's personal funds – NOT FROM CAMPAIGN FUNDS.**

The Village Clerk will review reports for timeliness of filing. **It is the Candidate's responsibility to ensure that the information contained in the report is true, correct, and in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida.**
