

ARTS, CULTURAL AND SPECIAL EVENTS BOARD

§ 32.60 Arts, Cultural and Special Events Board.

An Arts, Cultural and Special Events Board is hereby created which shall be composed of five (5) members, appointed by the City Commission to serve at the pleasure of the Commission without compensation. Each member shall be appointed by a majority vote of the City Commission.

§ 32.61 Qualification of members.

The members of the Arts, Cultural and Special Events Board shall be appointed and shall be qualified electors of the City as defined in the Charter and shall also be and remain during their respective terms of office, residents of the City.

§ 32.62 Terms; vacancies; removed from office.

Members of the Board shall be appointed by the City Commission for a term of two years. In the event that a vacancy shall occur on the Board by reason or resignation, removal, death, or for any other reason, a successor shall be appointed to fill the unexpired term for such member.

§ 32.65 Powers and duties.

(A) The Arts, Cultural and Special Events Board shall be charged with the duty and responsibilities to act in an advisory capacity to the City Commission and City Manager in matters pertaining to the delivery of the following human services:

- (1) Recreation and park planning activities.
- (2) Program financing and services.
- (3) Physical components of outdoor and indoor leisure, cultural and recreational activities to meet the needs of as many kinds of people as possible.
- (4) Social services and other human resources program planning with special emphasis on the needs of residents of the City.
- (5) Cooperate with all other similar governmental agencies and all public or private organizations working for the same or similar objectives.

(B) The Board shall submit to the City Manager and through him or her to the City Commission interim reports as to the performance of its duties and responsibilities as set forth above.
