

COMMUNITY ENHANCEMENT BOARD

§ 32.11 Composition

There is hereby created the North Bay Village Community Enhancement Board which shall consist of seven members who may reside at any location within the City, or owners of businesses located within the confines, or designees of such business owners; all of whom shall serve for a period of two years as provided in §6.01 of the Charter.

§ 32.12 Qualifications

The members of the Community Enhancement Board shall be appointed and shall be qualified electors of the City or owners of businesses located within the confines of the City, or designees of such business owners as defined in the Charter. Resident members of the Board shall also be and remain during their respective terms of office, residents of the City.

§ 32.13 Terms; removal from office.

The original members of the Community Enhancement Board shall be appointed by the City Commission, by a majority vote of the members present. Members of the Board shall be appointed by the City Commission for a term of two years. Any member may be removed from the office by the Commission upon majority vote of the Commission.

§ 32.16 Power and duties

The Community Enhancement Board shall be charged with the following duties:

1. To continually study the needs of the entire City for floral landscaping, including the entrances of the several islands and the median strips, including both privately owned and publicly owned property.
2. Determine the existence of alleged violations of law which adversely affect the aesthetics of the City.
3. Entertain complaints from citizens regarding existence of conditions which are detrimental to the aesthetic values and quality of life of the City.
4. To file a report of its activities with the City Commission and the City Manager, including the recommendations to the Commission for the beautification of the City at least once per year.
