



PROJECT FACT SHEET

Seawall Reconstruction

Dr. Vogel Park Improvement Project

North Bay Village started in mid-March 2014 a new project at Vogel Park. This project will last approximately 1 ½ months to complete and will cost an estimated \$69,565.00. This project has been deemed an emergency project by the Village Manager due to health and safety concerns.

Project Limits

This project will take place at the seawall at Vogel Park.

Scope & Purpose of Work

This project will address and repair the seawall at Dr. Paul Vogel Park. The seawall has gradually been deteriorating since the Village acquired the property for a community park and has now deteriorated to the point of creating a critical safety concern for the general public.

Maintenance of Traffic

There will be no lane closures associated with this project.

Project Schedule/Work Hours

Date Work will Begin: 3/17/2014; Date Work will End: 4/28/2014

It is anticipated that there will be no night time work. The actual work schedule is contingent upon field conditions.

Work will be performed only Mondays through Fridays. The actual work schedule is contingent upon field conditions.

Timeline

The project is scheduled to begin in mid-March 2014 and has estimated duration of 1 ½ month. Please note, however, that this schedule is tentative and could be impacted by bad weather or other unforeseen circumstances.

Inclement Weather Event

Should a weather event make evacuation necessary, the contractor will secure the work zone safely and cleared of loose materials in order to facilitate evacuation efforts.
