

## **NORTH BAY VILLAGE SIGNIFICANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS**

### **FISCAL YEAR 2014**

1. New high-security drop box installed for utility payments.
2. \$600,000 State Grant approved by Legislature for Storm Drain Improvements
3. \$240,000 Low Interest Loan eligibility approved from State Revolving Loan Fund for Drinking Water Line repairs.
4. \$240,000 Low Interest Loan eligibility approved from State Revolving Loan Fund for Water Meter Replacement Program.
5. OSHA required Ventilation System replaced in Main Sanitary Pump Station.
6. New Lighting System installed in Main Sanitary Pump Station.
7. Relocated Commission Chambers from TIES to Village Hall site.
8. Relocated Building Department, Post Office, and Utility Payments Window to 1<sup>st</sup> floor of Village Hall.
9. Lighting Fixtures installed for Treasure Island Monument Sign at Hispanola entrance.
10. Vogel Park Seawall Project completed.
11. New commercial grade fence installed along Vogel Park Seawall.
12. Baywalk Plaza Project re-activated and under design/50% Design Drawings completed.
13. New Computer Software Programs instituted for Utility Payments and Building Department.
14. GPS Pilot Project initiated for Police and Public Works vehicles.
15. Smartwater CSI Program initiated for Village residents.
16. Storm Drain system completely cleaned at start of Hurricane Season.
17. Complete CCTV evaluation of entire sanitary sewer system completed.
18. Complete Smoke Test of entire sanitary sewer system completed.
19. Concrete vehicle sidewalk approaches at the rear of the Lexi and entrance and exit to Pirates Aly removed and replaced.
20. Village hosted Farmer's Market weekly from March 23<sup>rd</sup> through June 22<sup>nd</sup>.
21. Village hosted Food Trucks monthly from April 2<sup>nd</sup> through June 4<sup>th</sup>.
22. Village obtained 12 Mini-14 Rifles from the Town of Sweetwater.
23. \$100,000 low interest loan eligibility approved from State Revolving Loan Fund for Storm Water Improvements.
24. Collective Bargaining Agreement with Police FOP finalized and executed by Village and FOP.
25. Westbound Village Welcome Sign installed/Eastbound sign under design.
26. Eight new Royal Palms installed in Paul Vogel Park.
27. Four replacement Royal Palms installed along Causeway median.
28. Received donated garbage truck from Miami-Dade County courtesy of Commissioner Sally Heyman.
29. Four new significant development projects were approved to move forward with construction.
30. Permanent sanitary sewer force main easement was approved by School Board.
31. TIES IB Program received supplementary funding from North Bay Village.

32. Water meter use audit conducted by Water Company of America.
33. Old Miami Beach Sanitary Force Main was rehabilitated for use in emergency situation.
