## OVERVIEW

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) is developing the design for a roadway project along SR 934/NE 79 Street Causeway, from North Bayshore Drive to Bay Drive West.

### PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This is a resurfacing, restoration and rehabilitation (RRR) project along SR-934/NE 79 Street Causeway from east of North Bayshore Drive to Bay Drive West for a project length of about two miles. The project traverses the City of Miami, North Bay Village, and the City of Miami Beach in Miami-Dade County. SR-934/NE 79 Street Causeway operates as a two-way urban corridor that is oriented in a west to east direction. The existing roadway section is a six-lane divided urban section that includes a five-foot wide sidewalk on the outside on both sides of the roadway, separated by a raised median.

### PROJECT SCHEDULE

Beginning construction – summer 2015

Anticipated end of construction – summer 2016

### ESTIMATED CONSTRUCTION COST

\$4.6 million

### PROJECT DETAILS

- Repaving and restriping
- Upgrade pedestrian curb ramps
- Provide missing detectable warning surfaces
- Upgrade signals to address issues and install pedestrian countdown signals
- Install new speed feedback signs along corridor
- Install new roadway lighting within the project limits
- Install new bridge railings on Bridge Nos. 870084 and 870550
- Incorporation of a permanent maintenance easement at Pelican Harbor Drive

### MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC (MOT)

The MOT will be designed to minimize adverse impacts to local residents and businesses during construction. It will also include maintenance of pedestrian traffic and provisions for compliant pedestrian paths, as well as specific attention to bus stops where required. There is pedestrian and bicyclist activity in the area, which should be maintained throughout the construction process.
