Please call 3-1-1 to make an appointment. All cats must be dropped off at the event at 7:30 a.m.**

This event is open to all residents of Miami-Dade County and to those working on the trap, neuter and release program to facilitate the reduction of community cats.

Requirements (NO EXCEPTIONS): Service for Miami-Dade County residents ONLY. Maximum of four (4) appointments per residential address. Proof of current rabies vaccination must be provided for all cats presented, otherwise they will be vaccinated for free. All cats will be sterilized, dewormed and ear- tipped. Veterinarian may decline surgery of any pet due to health reasons. Please call 3-1-1 to schedule an appointment.
