MDWASD 36 Inch Water Main Rehabilitation Project

SPECIAL PROJECT

Beginning Friday evening, August 14, 2015 The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (MDWASD) will be **PERFORMING A SPECIAL PROJECT** for the 36-inch water main rehabilitation on Northeast 79th Street. This MDWASD final installation project will take approximately 8 to 12 hours to be completed.

Project Limits

This MDWASD project will take place on the 79th Street Causeway on east and west bound lanes from east of Pelican Harbor Island up to Adventure Avenue.

Scope & Purpose of Work

This **special project** portion of the work will include the final installation of the water line at the intersection of Larry Paskow Way and 79th Street Causeway. There will also be a valve replacement on the 79th Street Causeway in front of Channel 7. There will be water pressure reduction throughout North Bay Village due to a series of valve closures that need to occur for the work to proceed. The pressure reduction is expected to occur around 1:00 AM Saturday, 08/15/15. Most work will be performed on the East bound lanes. There will be a point in the project where there will be work on the West bound lanes. During work on the West bound lanes traffic may be diverted. This work will be performed at night on 08/14/15 for 8 to 12 hrs.

Maintenance of Traffic

Date Work will Begin: 08/14/2015; Date Work will End: Approximately 08/15/2015 – Work will last for 8 to 12 hours

Lane closures will be as follows:

During the day, one east bound lane will be closed at all times.

Day Time Work will Begin: 8:00 AM
Day Time Work Will End: 4:00 PM
Total Number of Lanes - 3
Number Closed - 1
Number Opened – 2

During the night, two east and west bound lanes will be closed at all times.

Night Time Work will Begin: 6:00 PM
Night Time Work Will End: 6:00 AM
West bound Lanes Closure at various times
Total Number of Lanes - 3
Number Closed - 2
Number Opened - 1

This is a special project and this work will occur on Friday 08/14/15 for 8 to 12 hours. During lane closures, motorists will be guided through the work zone by warning signs, police officers, trained flagging personnel, barricades, and other channelizing devices.

Timeline

The special project is scheduled to begin on 08/14/15 and has project duration of 1 day. Please note, however, that this schedule is tentative and could be impacted by bad weather or other unforeseen circumstances.
